Units who already have an account:

Note – Each South Florida Council BSA unit has a login already. If your unit has registered for Merit Badge College in the past, it is the same account. If you do not have that login, please contact Jeanine Kinsey at 954-778-0599 for assistance.

Go to https://southfl.tentaroo.com and log in.

Non-South Florida Council BSA Units without an account:

- 1. Go to https://southfl.tentaroo.com
- 2. Select Create Account
- 3. Select the Scoutmasters Camporee Event to create your account for Once created, new accounts can also be used for other event registrations.
- 4. Complete the unit information and Create your username and password
- Check your email for the confirmation email.
 The email comes from South Florida Council Cliff Freiwald and the subject is "South Florida Council Please verify your new account"
- 6. Click on the Activate Account link in the email.
- 7. Close your browser and then go back to https://southfl.tentaroo.com and log in.
- 8. Follow the instructions below to Register for the Event

Non-Boy Scouts of America units and families who do not have an account yet:

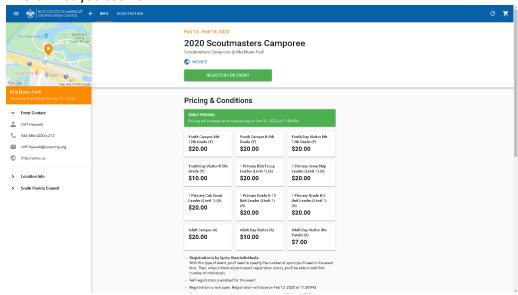
Note – Each family/unit can have a single login. If your email address is already in use with another account, you will not be able to use it to create a new account.

- 1. Go to https://southfl.tentaroo.com
- 2. Select Create Account
- 3. Select the Scoutmasters Camporee Event to create your account for Once created, new accounts can also be used for other event registrations.
- 4. Change the registration type from "Unit" to "Individual / Family"
- 5. Name:
 - For Other Youth Groups Enter your organization as the first name and your **FULL** unit number as the last name. For Families Use the parent/adult first name and last name
- 6. Create your username and password
- 7. Check your email for the confirmation email.
 - The email comes from South Florida Council Cliff Freiwald and the subject is "South Florida Council Please verify your new account"
- 8. Click on the Activate Account link in the email.
- 9. Close your browser and then go back to https://southfl.tentaroo.com and log in.
- 10. Follow the instructions below to Register for the Event

Register for an Event:

- 1. Once logged in, click "Go To Events"
- 2. Select Scoutmasters Camporee from the available list
- 3. Select the event itself from the next page

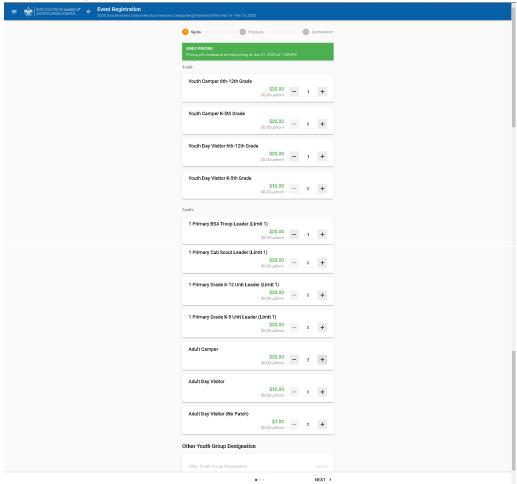
4. This is what you see now:



5. Click Register for Event

Select your "Spots" or Participants:

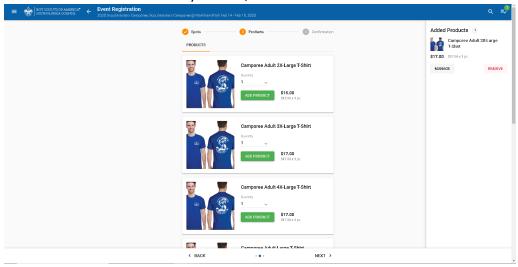
- 1. You must add 1, and ONLY 1 of the "Primary" unit leader types in order to reserve a campsite. Select the correct one for your unit type. Use "Adult Camper" for all other adults in the unit.
- 2. You may also select the number of youth and adults you plan to bring. DO NOT OVER ESTIMATE HERE!
- **3.** You will not have to pay for them today, and you can come back any time before January 31st to pay for these and/or add more at the \$20 price. After that, the price goes up to \$25
- **4.** See the example screen with some selections made:



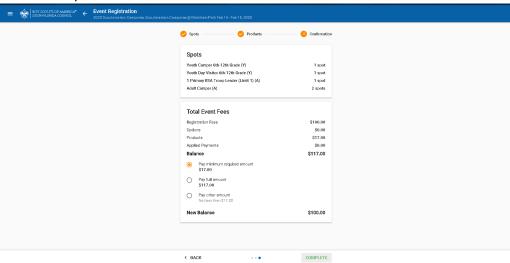
- 5. Select only 1 Primary unit leader type as well as any other spots you want today
- 6. Scroll to the bottom and add your Other Unit Designation (Scouts BSA Girl Troop, Other organization name, troop number and council, or District if you are a Scouts BSA troop from outside South Florida Council)
- 7. Then click "Next"

Select any products you want to pre-order (Before January 15th ONLY):

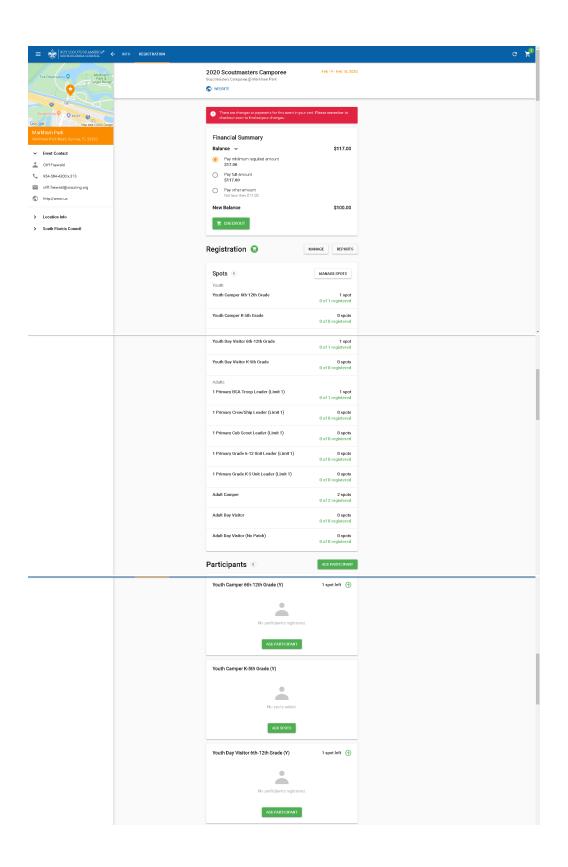
1. Select the number of each size you need, and then click "Add Product"



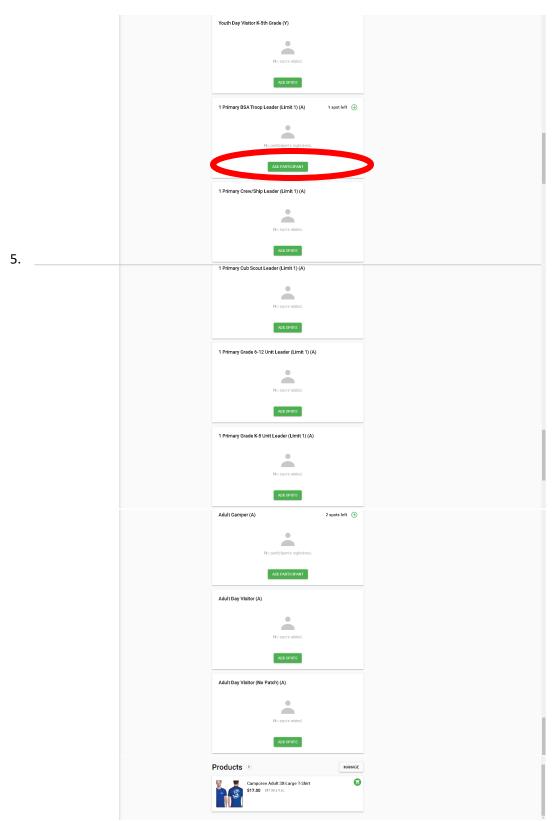
- 2. Click Next at the bottom of the screen

I did say it was long, right?

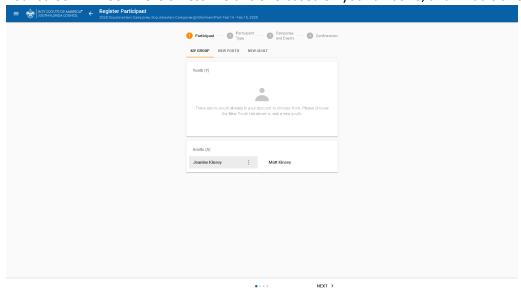


6. The screenshot shows what it looks like based on the selections I made above. Note the "Add Particpant" buttons below the "Spots" that I selected previously.

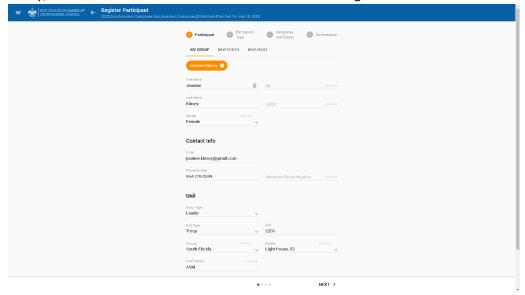
Campsite Selection – includes selecting Pack events, Troop events and volunteering for the Primary Leader:

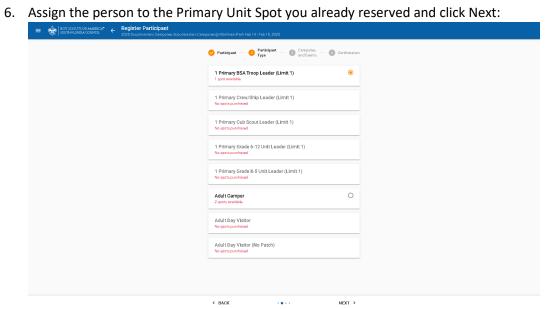
- 1. You must add a name to the "Primary" unit leader type in order to reserve a campsite.
- 2. To do that, scroll down the page until you see your primary Unit leader type and the button that says "Add Participant" below it. (See the big red circle at the top of this page)

3. Your screen will look more or less like this one based on your unit size, and what is already in your account:



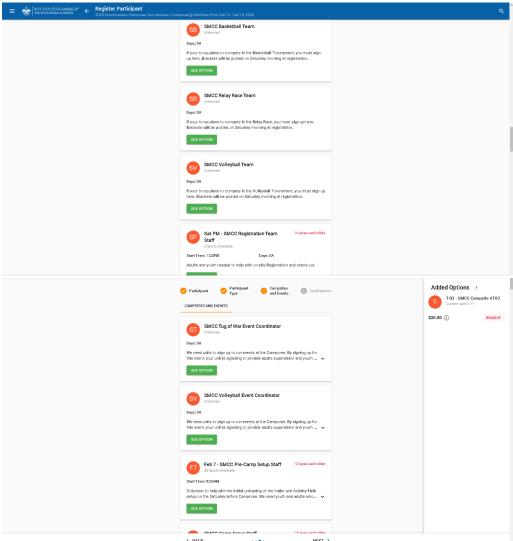
- 4. You can either select one of the adult names already showing up (Jeanine and Matt) or click Add New Adult at the top of the screen.
- 5. Verify, or fill in all of the information for the leader in charge and then click Next.





And now you have reached the page where you select all of your campsites, portalets, volunteering options, unit events/or pack events. This page will change constantly as units/volunteers sign up for various sites and roles, so I have only shown a couple of examples here:

(Campsites tend to sort to the bottom of the page, so use the Ctrl-F in your browser to search for items, or scroll down until you find them)



7. Each site is for one unit, and units must camp in the age appropriate site Based on your Primary Unit Leader type, you will have appropriate sites to select from.

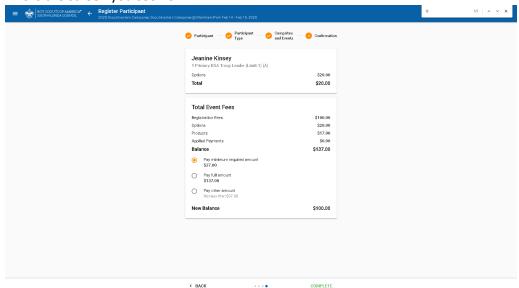

Troops/6th-12th **Grade units** also need to select whether or not they are participating in Basketball, Volleyball, Tug-of-War, Relay, or are willing to run an event

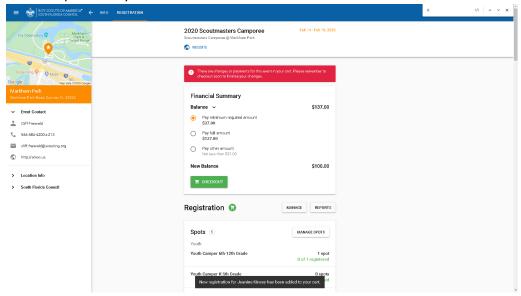
Packs/K-5th Grade units need to select a Pack Event to run on Saturday morning

- 8. We need adult volunteers to help run events, so if the primary leader can help, please select their choices here too.
- 9. Scroll to the bottom and click "Complete"

10. This is the screen you see now:



11. Click Complete and you are back to this screen:

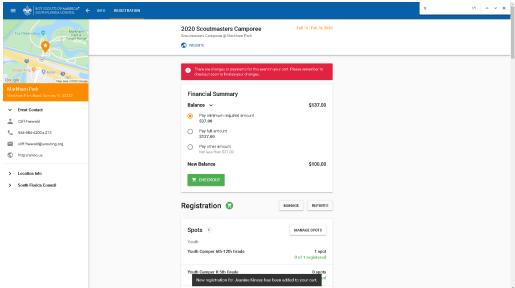


- 12. If you want to sign other adults and/or youth up for volunteering, or provide your complete unit roster, see the instructions on the next page.
- 13. If you are done for now, you can select the amount you want to pay today and click "Checkout" and complete your payment.

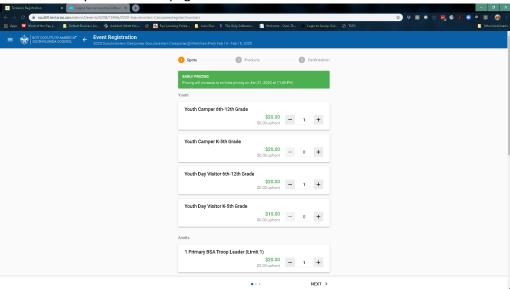
REMEMBER THAT WHILE YOU ONLY <u>HAVE</u> TO PAY FOR THE CAMPSITE AND PRODUCTS RIGHT AWAY, YOU MUST PAY THE BALANCE IN FULL BEFORE JANUARY 31ST TO GET THE \$20 RATE AND HAVE YOUR PORTALET! ANY PORTALETS NOT PAID FOR BY THEN WILL BE DELETED FROM YOUR CART AND YOUR UNPAID CAMPERS WILL BE \$25.

Adding Participants and other options later

- 1. Log in with the same account you reserved the campsite
- 2. Once logged in, click "Go To Events"
- 3. Select Scoutmasters Camporee from the available list
- 4. Select the event itself from the next page as you did before, and you are back at this page:

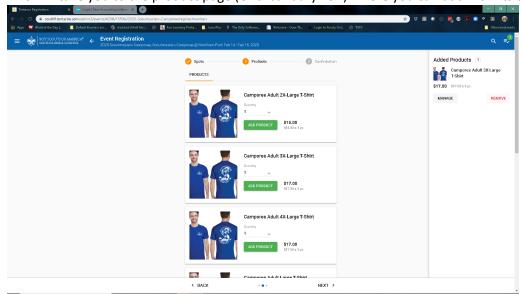


- 5. To add more participants, Click "Manage Spots" below the Shopping Cart summary
- 6. You will end up back on this page:

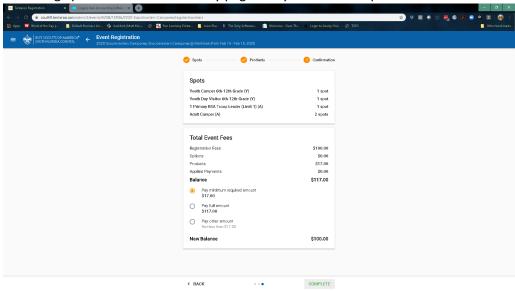


7. Make any changes you want to your counts and click Next

8. This will take you to the product page (Until January 15th) where you can add T-Shirts to your order:



- 9. Make any changes you need, and then click Next
- 10. This brings you back to the summary page and you click "Complete" at the bottom



- 11. You are now back to the firs screen from this section again.
- 12. In order to sign someone up to volunteer, you must add their name to the spot just as you did for the primary unit leader when you first registered, and then add them to the volunteer position(s) they want to fill. Thee are volunteer positions for youth and adults.
- 13. You do not have to provide the names of everyone attending unless they are volunteering. If you do not add everyone online, you will need to bring a completed unit roster with you (available at www.smcc.us)
- 14. If you add the names of all your youth and adults before February 12th, you will not need to provide a separate roster to the staff.
- 15. You can come back as often as needed to add more participants as long as you do so before February 12th. Early pricing ends on January 31st and all unpaid participants costs will automatically go up at that time.
