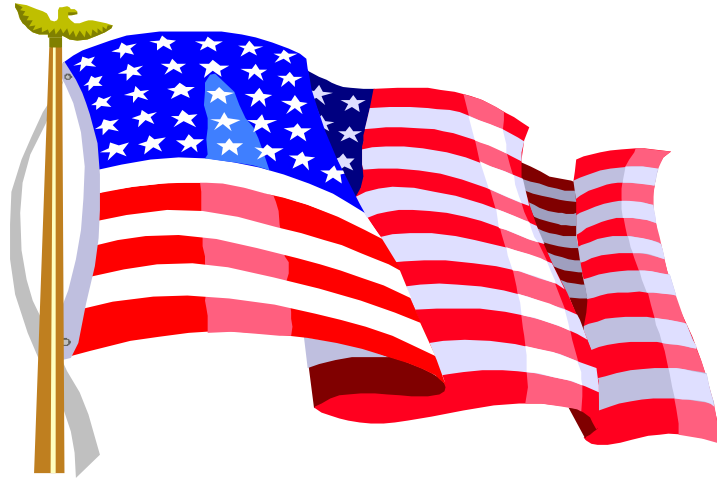


# Memorial Day Parade & Service

**Monday, May 28, 2018**

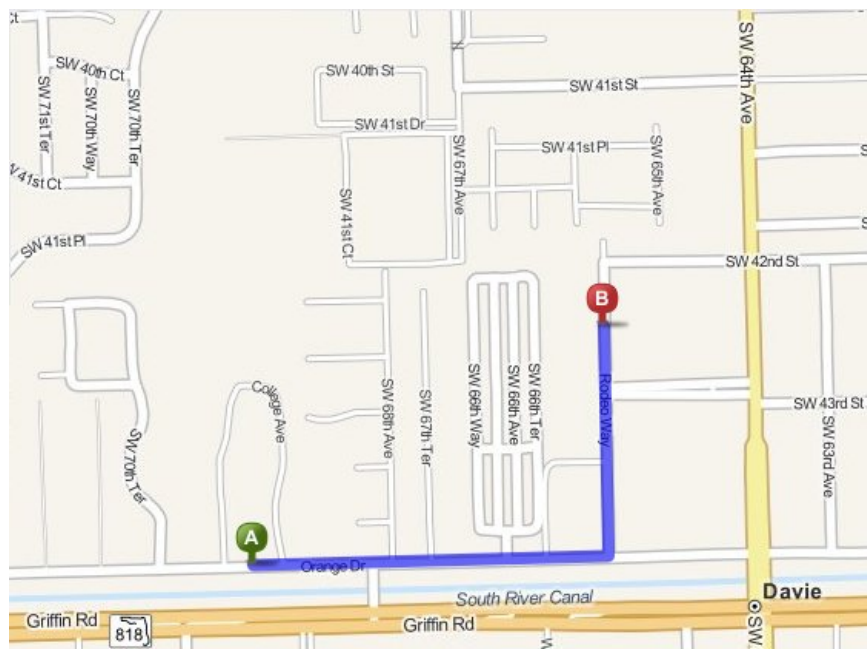
- 10 AM **Memorial Day Parade – Assembly at Davie Fire Administration (6905 Orange Drive).**
- 10:30 AM **Memorial Day Parade – Step Off.** Please be assembled and ready.
- 11:00 AM **Memorial Day Ceremony – held in the Davie Bergeron Rodeo Arena (4271 Davie Rd)**

FLAGS will be available for purchase prior to parade step-off for \$1.00. During the service, flags (purchased or brought) can be placed on the ceremonial veterans' grave markers.

The Scoutmasters Camporee Committee will arrange the placement of these flags on veterans' graves at local cemeteries on Veterans Day, 2018. We would be happy to have the assistance of your group at that event for this meaningful service to our fallen heroes.

The Memorial Day Weekend activities are an official South Florida Council Scouting activity. The Town of Davie donates significant manpower and resources to assure a successful event. As a Scoutmaster, Cubmaster, or unit leader, you are encouraged to participate in this worthwhile event. ## Memorial Day Parade – Monday, May 28, 2018

All entries must be registered with the parade chairman. This is necessary to insure a space will be assigned for your organization.

All applications must be received by the Parade Chairman, Jeanine Kinsey, by Thursday, May 24, 2018. Register online at [smcc.us](http://smcc.us) or use the form on this page.

Assembly of all entrants will be at 10 AM. The Parade Chairman will give you directions. Groups will assemble in or near the parking lot of the Davie Fire Administration at 6905 Orange Drive. The parade will start at 10:30 AM sharp. Please park at the Administration property or at the Bergeron Rodeo Grounds and be careful not to park on private property or in marked towing zones.

\*\*\* PLEASE BE PROMPT \*\*\*

The route of the parade will be as follows: East on Orange Drive. North on Rodeo Way, then into the entrance of the Bergeron Rodeo Grounds Arena. When marching units enter the arena, please be seated in the bleachers around the south side of the arena.

The Memorial Services will begin at approximately 11 AM and will last approximately one hour. All entrants will receive a participation recognition ribbon.
